The Indonesian International Vocational Student Mobility Awards (IIVOSMA) is one of the Merdeka Belajar Kampus Merdeka (MBKM) programs, established and organized by The Indonesian Ministry of Education, Culture, Research, and Technology. IIVOSMA offers scholarships to vocational students for a one-semester study at an international partner universities. The program emphasizes real lab work and/or industrial exposure to help students improve their knowledge, soft skills, and global competence.

IIVOSMA creates chances for universities in Indonesia and worldwide to establish and eventually expand cooperation and partnerships. This program also strives to build and facilitate alumni associations to better serve the nation through their enhanced knowledge, soft skills, cross-cultural awareness, language and communication abilities, and worldwide network.
